WHY BICS MATTERS

BICS reduces electricity costs for qualifying manufacturers by exempting eligible businesses from 3 tariffs & levys.

For manufacturers with high electricity usage, this could deliver significant annual savings, improving competitiveness and supporting long-term investment in UK operations.

BICS is most relevant to businesses involved in:

- Advanced manufacturing; Offshore wind supply chain
